MISSION BRIEFING

Intended Audience: Beginners (children, parents, teachers).

Goal: Discover your **Secret Code**

Name using the Shape Alphabet!

Time: 5-10 minutes.

MATERIALS NEEDED

Flashcards for: The letters in the learner's name.

Optional: None.

ACTIVITY STEPS

STEP 1: The Briefing.

Say: "Agent, your new mission is to learn your secret code name. We're going to spell your real name using the Shape Alphabet."

STEP 2: Say the letters

"Your name is [Student's Name].

Let's spell it:

[Letter]-[Letter]-[Letter]."

- Example: "Your name is Sam. That's S-A-M."

STEP 3: Meet the Shapes

- Teacher places the Flashcards randomly.
- Say: "Now let's find the shape for each letter in your name."

- The student finds the CORRESPONDING Flashcard for each letter and arranges them in order. Example: S-A-M

- "S is the... Steel Hook"
- "A is the... Step Ladder"
- "M is the... Comfy Hammock"

STEP 4: Practice their Code Name

Have them repeat after you: "My code name is Steel Hook - Step Ladder - Comfy Hammock."

WHY THIS WORKS

- It uses the learner's name for maximum engagement.
- No materials needed beyond flashcards.
- Pure speaking and listening practice.
- It creates a personal connection to the alphabet.
- It builds confidence quickly.
